	Wool Market Movements
•	The Australian wool market posted a solid rise in prices
	before the Easter Recess week. The EMI rose by 9 cents to
	1239 Ac/kg while the WMI lifted by strong 28 cents to
	again break the 1300 c/kg level to finish at 1309c/kg. The
	increases came in spite of yet another lift in the A\$ against
	the US\$. The A\$ rose by 0.26 UScents for the week and
	closed at 76.23 UScents. The EMI in US\$ rose by 12 US
	cents to 944 USc/kg. There were 43,508 bales offered for
	the week, with a pass-in rate of 4.2%.

- The Sydney sale this week was held at the Sydney Royal Easter Show. Prices for Merino fleece wool lifted on Tuesday, with the most significant gains seen for medium to broad merino wool which posted a rise of 10-20 cents. Most finer Merino fleece wools rose by 5-10 cents. Crossbred wool prices eased by up to 5 cents. Locks rose by 10 cents and crutchings were firm. The strong buyer interest in Merino fleece wool continued on Wednesday and prices lifted by up to 20 cents, mainly for 20-21 micron wool. A limited offering of Crossbred wool saw prices unchanged. Oddments continued to rise, up by 5-10 cents.
- In contrast to the gains in Sydney, Melbourne posted only small increases of up to 5 cents for Merino fleece wool on Tuesday, mainly at the fine end. Crossbred wool prices were mixed, with finer microns tending dearer but broader microns easing. Oddments were unchanged on last week's levels. Buyer interest gathered momentum on Wednesday and prices for Merino fleece wool lifted by around 15 cents. Some microns rose by as much as 20 cents. Crossbred wool prices were flat. Locks rose by 5-10 cents and crutchings were firm.
- Fremantle recorded the strongest lift in prices of the three selling centres on both days of sales this week. On Tuesday, buyer demand was solid for all microns, with the largest price gains of 15 cents seen for the limited offering of broader Merino wool. All other fleece wools gained 5-10 cents. Locks and crutchings lifted by 10-15 cents for the day. The price rises continued on Wednesday, with the medium wools increasing by 15-20 cents, and finer wools rising 10-15 cents. Locks and crutchings were unchanged.


