Wool Market Movements



TTOOL MAINTON MOTORING
The Australian wool market faltered this week as
demand for Merino wool came off the boil after the
recent strong demand conditions. The EMI slid 10 cents
to 1534 c/kg, after lifting on Wednesday and then falling
on Thursday. Virtually all Merino wool prices fell in all
centres, and by as much as 70 cents in Fremantle. In
contrast, Crossbred wool prices were firm to slightly
higher. The falls in Merino wool prices came despite a
weaker AUD. The AUD slid by 0.7 US cents to 73.5
UScents, the lowest since June 2016. In USD terms, the
EMI fell by 19 UScents to 1127 USc/kg. 38,028 bales were
offered for the week, of which 16.1% were passed-in.

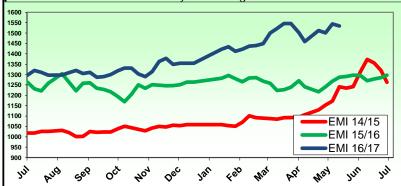
• The two-day sale in Sydney opened solidly on
Wednesday, with generally steady prices for Merino
wool and increased demand for Crossbred wool. Good
buyer interest in better style and strength Merino wool
helped support Merino prices. Demand for Merino wool
fell away on Thursday, with prices down by around 30
cents, give or take. Crossbred wool prices eased.
Oddments did better than fleece wool, gaining a little
ground.

- Melbourne was the best performed of the three selling centres, with good demand for Merino fleece wool on Wednesday pushing prices higher. This was lost on Thursday as demand waned and prices fell. Medium and broad Merino wool prices were 15-30 ccents lower for the week, while fine Merino wool did better. Demand for Crossbred wool was solid and prices firm to higher over the week. Locks, Stains and Crutchings were steady.
- Fremantle found the going toughest of the three centres, with prices falling on both sale days. 18 and 18.5 micron wool fared best, falling by 15-20 cents for the week while the more plentiful supplies of 20 to 22 micron met the strongest buyer resistence and prices fell by 50-70 cents. In contrast to the soft market for Merino fleece wool Oddments saw good price rises of between 5 and 10 cents over the week.
