## Wool Market Movements

### Friday, 12 January 2018

Prices surged again this week as the Australian wool market resumed after the annual three-week Christmas recess. Buyers competed strongly for the Merino wool on offer, with all microns, styles and specs enjoying large price rises. The large offering of Crossbred wool also attracted buyer interest and prices lifted. The EMI closed at another new record of 1758 c/kg, up by 58 cents. The increase came despite the AUD being more than 2 USc higher than prior to the Recess, at 78.7 USc. The EMI rose by 82 UScents to 1431 USc/kg. There were 53,517 bales offered of which 3.1% were passed-in.

- Melbourne hosted a three day sale with 26,944 bales on offer, more than half the national offering. The sale opened on Tuesday with strong price rises for fine Merino wool and good price gains for all other microns. Wednesday's sale saw buyers ramp up their interest in Merino wool, with price gains of 40 to 60 cents. Crossbreds were more mixed, with smaller price rises for finer microns and easier prices for broader wools. The market steadied on Thursday, with more modest rises for fine Merino wool and steady prices for broader Merino wools. Fine Crossbreds rose by 15-20 cents. Oddments lifted by 40 to 60 cents over the week, despite easier prices on Thursday.
- There were just 12,777 bales on offer at Sydney's two-day sale. Bidding on the Merino offering opened strongly on Wednesday, with price gains of 40 to 60 cents. 17 micron and finer wools gained 80 cents. The increases were a little smaller on Thursday, at around 20-30 cents, with the exception of ultrafine wool which were up 80 cents. Fine Crossbred wools enjoyed a good week, with prices lifting by 10-20 cents on Wednesday and a further 15-20 cents on Thursday. Prices for broad Crossbred wool eased on both days. A limited offering of Oddments saw prices lift by 20 to 70 cents on Wednesday and then 10-30 cents on Thursday.
- The two-day Fremantle sale saw strong bidding for the 13,796 bales on offer. There were very strong price gains over the week, with the largest increases recorded on Wednesday as buyers competed strongly for the available wools. Prices jumped by 50-90 cents for fleece, skirtings and Oddments on Wednesday. The market steadied a little on Thursday, although prices for fleece and skirtings were still 10-25 cents higher. Locks, stains and crutchings gained a further 5 to 15 cents.

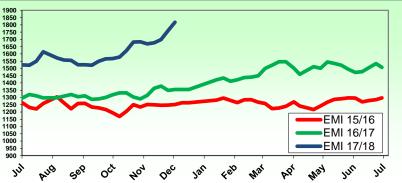
